BOY GETS NEW LIFE WITH A STRAIGHT BACK!

Helping a 10-year-old boy to a new and better life has earned a prestigious award for Florida Chiropractor Dr. Channing Bolick.

The “Miracle Award for Clinical Excellence” is an honor presented annually by the Palmer College of Chiropractic in Davenport, Iowa. Dr. Bolick received the 2006 award for his remarkable work in straightening a major curve in the youth’s spine.

Dr. Bolick began seeing the child in early 2006. The boy had earlier been diagnosed with the learning and social problems connected with autism. A Chiropractic exam that included x-rays of the boy’s back showed that he had a 21-degree lateral scoliosis (curve) in the spine.

Eleven manual Chiropractic adjustments were delivered from February 1st to the 27th. After this series of treatments, x-rays showed no trace of scoliosis.

“Subjectively, the patient reported his chronic back pain was gone,” said Dr. Bolick. “His coordination had improved, his attention span had increased, and he was more able to focus. The boy also reported better muscle balance and a diminished problem with echolalia.” (Echolalia is a condition where an individual feels compelled to immediately repeat back whatever is said to him.)

Dr. Bolick was very honored to receive the award and very pleased with the boy’s progress. “One of the noteworthy aspects to this case was that the boy’s scoliosis, or abnormal lateral spinal curvature, was corrected through Chiropractic adjustments alone,” he said. “No other therapies were used.”
